**Abstract:** Provides relative to the quarterly reporting requirements of jail facilities to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections.

Proposed law provides for definitions for the following terms: "average daily population", "case disposition", "confined inmate", "hold", "jail facility", "jail management system", "municipal offense", "operational capacity", "sentenced inmate", and "unsentenced inmate".

Proposed law requires the keeper of each jail facility to keep and maintain a daily record of certain data provided for in proposed law.

Proposed law requires each jail facility to submit a quarterly report, beginning Jan. 15, 2021, to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections through an electronic survey designed by the department.

Proposed law provides that if a jail facility fails to submit a quarterly report within 30 days after a reporting date, the jail facility is considered noncompliant for the reporting period. Requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to send a notice to the noncompliant jail facility.
