Abstract: Authorizes driver's license applicants to update their permanent address by mail or online.

Present law requires a person to notify the driver's license division in writing within 10 days of a change of address after applying for a driver's license.

Proposed law authorizes a licensee to update their permanent address in person, by mail, or online to have their license issued with the correct address for Class "D" and "E" licenses.

Proposed law requires the reconstructed license be mailed to the licensee's updated permanent address.

Proposed law prohibits the application of proposed law to the REAL ID.

Proposed law requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles, to promulgate and adopt rules and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, necessary to implement the provisions of proposed law.
