

1 WHEREAS, R.S. 39:52.1 provides that a change to the expenditure limit shall be
2 made pursuant to a concurrent resolution adopted by a favorable vote of two-thirds of the
3 elected members of each house directing the commissioner of administration to change the
4 expenditure limit to a designated amount for a specified fiscal year.

5 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana, two-thirds of
6 the elected members of each house concurring, does hereby direct the commissioner of
7 administration to change the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 from
8 \$14,353,474,249 to \$13,302,068,317.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution shall be
10 construed to affect the expenditure limit for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and thereafter in
11 accordance with Article VII, Section 10(C) of the Constitution of Louisiana.
