MINERALS: Provides relative to the nature of production payments

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 31:212.21, relative to production payments; to eliminate
3 redundant terminology; to provide relative to the nature and classification of
4 production payments; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 31:212.21 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §212.21. Nonpayment of production payment or royalties; notice prerequisite to
8 judicial demand

9 If the owner of a ~~mineral~~ production payment created out of a mineral lessee's
10 interest or a royalty owner other than a mineral lessor seeks relief for the failure of
11 a mineral lessee to make timely or proper payment of royalties or the production
12 payment, he must give his obligor written notice of such failure as a prerequisite to
13 a judicial demand for damages.

Abstract: Provides for clarification of the nature of production payments and eliminates redundancy in terminology.

Present law requires written notice of the nonpayment of a production payment to be provided prior to a judicial demand for damages.

Proposed law retains present law but eliminates the linguistic redundancy and clarifies the application of present law by stating explicitly that the interest at issue is one created out of a mineral lessee's interest.
