**Abstract:** Provides an exception to the crime of illegal carrying of weapons for persons who may lawfully possess a firearm and who carry a concealed firearm during a mandatory evacuation in a declared state of emergency or disaster.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 14:95) prohibits the carrying of a concealed firearm, provides for criminal penalties, and provides for certain exceptions to the offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> creates an exception to the <u>present law</u> crime for any person who is not prohibited from possessing a firearm pursuant to <u>present</u> state or federal <u>law</u> and who is carrying a concealed firearm on or about his person while in the act of evacuating during a mandatory evacuation order issued during a state of emergency or disaster declared pursuant to the <u>present law</u> La. Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act.

For purposes of <u>proposed law</u>, "in the act of evacuating" is defined as the immediate and urgent movement of a person away from the evacuation area within 48 hours after a mandatory evacuation is ordered. The 48-hour period may be extended by an order issued by the governor.
