<u>Present law</u> provides for the transfer of certain schools in a district in academic crisis to the Recovery School District.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the legislative auditor to conduct a performance audit on every charter school in a school system that has had one or more schools transferred to the Recovery School District pursuant to R.S. 17:10.7, that was granted a charter between January 1, 2005, and January 1, 2020. The audit, at a minimum, shall identify and analyze the different and

Further requires the legislative auditor to submit a report of audit findings to the Senate and House committees on education by 9/30/2021.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the issuance of new charters in such a school system until the audits are performed and the required report submitted.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not apply to the renewal of an existing charter that has a school performance letter grade of "D" or higher.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
