26	pronounced in the defendant's absence, he shall be resentenced when his
27	presence is secured.
28	B. Nothing in this Article prohibits the court, by local rule, from
29	providing for a defendant's appearance at the pronouncement of sentence by
30	simultaneous audio-visual transmission in accordance with the provisions of
31	Article 562."
