## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

Proposed resolution will result in a one-time SGF expenditure of \$25,680 for the LA Dept. of Revenue in FY 21 for programming costs. LDR contemplates carrying out the duties of the resolution by conducting internal analyses and a secure, voluntary online survey sent to select taxpayers representing various populations by a number of criteria (industry types, asset and income sizes, geographic locations, etc.). The surveys would allow taxpayers to securely self-report expected impacts on revenue due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Estimates from the Office of Technology Services provided to LDR indicate an expected cost of \$25,680 to develop the survey and extract the responses in a usable format.

LDR also anticipates marginal printing and mailing costs associated with sending taxpayers survey invitation letters. The department anticipates these expenditures will be absorbed utilizing existing resources.

Note: As a result of expenses associated with this resolution being related to COVID-19, they may potentially be defrayed by federal funds. However, it is unknown at this time if these expenditures will qualify for federal aid disbursed to the state.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
