Abstract: Lowers the value threshold for reporting abandoned property to the state treasurer <u>from</u> \$50 to \$10 and for advertising unclaimed property <u>from</u> \$50 to \$100.

<u>Present law</u> provides a mechanism for businesses to transfer abandoned property to the state treasurer. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 9:159) requires abandoned property to be reported when it has a value of \$50 or more. Proposed law lowers this to a value of \$10 or more.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 9:161) requires the treasurer, as administrator of unclaimed property, to advertise the name and address or location of an owner of unclaimed property having a total value greater than \$50. Proposed law raises the threshold from \$50 to \$100.

(Amends R.S. 9:159(B)(1)-(3) and 161(B))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Appropriations</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

1. Remove provision in <u>proposed law</u> that would have required holders of presumed abandoned property with a value of \$10 or more to attempt to notify the owner.
