LOCAL EMPLOYEES. Requires the office of state examiner to develop online testing for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer applicants. (1/1/21)

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact the introductory paragraph of R.S. 33:2491, (E), and (I), 2492(1), (2),
3	and (11), 2494(A) and (D), the introductory paragraph of 2551, (5), and (9), 2552(1),
4	(2), and (11), 2553(C), and 2554(A) and (D), relative to in-service training for
5	certain public employees; to provide for the development and implementation of an
6	online testing program for prospective police officers and firefighters by the office
7	of state examiner; and to provide for related matters.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 33:2491, (E), and (I), 2492(1), (2), and
10	(11), 2494(A) and (D), the introductory paragraph of 2551, (5), and (9), 2552(1), (2), and
11	(11), 2553(C), and 2554(A) and (D) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
12	§2491. Establishment and maintenance of employment lists
13	Except for entrance level firefighter and entrance level police officer,
14	Tthe board shall establish and maintain employment lists containing names of
15	persons eligible for appointment to the various classes of positions in the classified
16	service, as follows:

1	E. Any person whose name is placed upon the competitive employment list
2	for the entrance or lowest ranking class in the classified service who has served in
3	the armed forces of the United States of America during the times of war, and has

5	added to his final test score a total of five points at the time of placing his name upon
6	the list. Proof of such service and discharge shall be required by the board or the
7	state examiner in any manner it deems advisable.

9	I. (1) For purposes of entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, the
10	state examiner shall establish and maintain a statewide eligibility list containing
11	names of persons eligible for appointment to these classes by any municipality,
12	parish, or fire protection district under the municipal fire and police civil
13	service system.
14	(2) A person who has attained a passing score on an examination
15	administered by the state examiner for entrance police officer, entrance firefighter,
16	entrance jailer, secretary to the chief, departmental records clerk, or for the entrance
17	classes for which the operation and maintenance of radio, alarm, or signal systems
18	for the respective fire or police services is the primary duty may have his name
19	placed on the employment list of any municipality, parish, or fire protection district
20	under the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service System, provided the person's
21	application and score are accepted by the board of the municipality, parish, or fire
22	protection district in which he seeks employment. In order that his name may be
23	placed upon the employment eligibility list, a person shall be required to meet the
24	minimum qualifications adopted as rules of the respective civil service board, as if
25	making original application for admission to the test. The eligibility of such an
26	applicant shall not continue past the date on which his original eligibility expired.
27	§2492. Tests
28	Tests to determine the eligibility of applicants for entry upon the promotional
29	and competitive employment lists shall be provided, as follows:

1 (1)(a) The board shall provide through the state examiner for promotional or 2 competitive tests. Official notice of examination shall be posted on the bulletin board 3 in each station of the respective department. The notice shall state (i) class of 4 positions for which tests will be given, (ii) whether the tests will be given on a 5 promotional or competitive basis, and (iii) the final date on which applications for 6 admission to the tests will be received. The notice shall be posted for a continuous 7 period of thirty ten days preceding the date for administering the tests.

8 (b) In addition to the posted notice, public notice for all tests to be given on 9 a competitive basis shall be published at least four times during the thirty-day period 10 in the official journal of the municipality on the state examiner's website and the 11 municipality's website, if available, during the ten-day period in which such tests are to be held. This notice of examination need not reveal the exact date on which 12 13 tests shall be administered, but all applicants shall be advised of the date, place, and 14 time to report for an announced test at least five days in advance thereof in any 15 manner the board may prescribe.

16 (2)(a) For entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, the state examiner shall publish notice on his website for ten-day notice of the location 17 for where such tests are to be held and the final date on which applications for 18 admission to the test will be received. This notice of examination shall reveal the 19 20 exact date on which the test shall be administered. However, all applicants shall 21 be advised of the time and place to report for an announced test at least five 22 days in advance in any manner the state examiner may prescribe. The state examiner shall provide for online entrance firefighter and entrance police 23 24 testing as provided for in this Section by Fiscal Year 2022.

(b) As may be necessary from time to time, the state examiner may call for
and administer examinations for the entrance classifications of firefighter, police
officer, secretary to the chief, departmental records clerk, jailer, and for the
entrance classes for positions of which the operation and maintenance of a radio,
alarm, or signal system for the fire or police service is the primary duty. Tests may

1 be administered at the discretion of the state examiner in any municipality, parish, 2 or fire protection district to which this Part applies. Official notification shall not be 3 made to the extent required under Paragraph (1) of this Section; however, public 4 notice shall be published at least four times during a thirty-day period in the official 5 journal of the state of Louisiana and may be posted on the bulletin board in each station of the respective department. This notice of examination need not state the 6 7 exact date on which tests shall be administered, but all applicants shall be advised 8 of the date, place, and time to report for an announced test at least five days in 9 advance thereof in any manner the state examiner may prescribe.

11 (11) Each applicant who makes a passing score on a test administered by the 12 state examiner under the provisions of Paragraph (2) of this Section shall be advised, 13 in any manner the state examiner prescribes, of his final score. Except for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, Ssuch score may be reported and approved 14 by the board under the provisions of R.S. 33:2491(I). The original eligibility of an 15 16 applicant under the provisions of this Paragraph shall be the period of not more than eighteen months after the date on which the signature of the state examiner was 17 18 affixed to his notification of score.

- 20 §2494. Certification and appointment

A.(1) Except for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, 21 Wwhenever the appointing authority proposes to fill a vacancy in the classified 22 service, except by demotion, transfer, emergency appointment, or by substitute 23 24 employment not to exceed thirty days, he shall request the board to certify names of persons eligible for appointment to the vacant position. The board shall thereupon 25 certify in writing the names of eligible persons from the appropriate employment list, 26 27 and the appointing authority shall, if he fills the vacancy, make the appointment as provided by this Section. 28

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(2) Whenever the appointing authority proposes to fill a vacancy in

The state examiner shall certify in writing the names of eligible4persons from the appropriate list, and the appointing authority shall, if he fills5the vacancy, make the appointment as provided by this Section.

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7 D. Certification and appointment from the competitive list shall be limited 8 to those conditions and classifications for which the competitive test may be given 9 as provided by R.S. 33:2492(E). Upon the appointing authority's request for the 10 certification of eligible persons from which he may fill a vacancy, and if the 11 competitive list is the appropriate list from which the names of eligible persons shall 12 be certified, the board or the state examiner shall certify the names of the persons 13 upon that list, in the order in which they appear thereon, for the class in which the vacancy is to be filled. The appointing authority shall select and appoint to the first 14 vacancy to be filled, any one of the persons so certified to him for the vacancy. In 15 16 making appointments to entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, the appointing authority shall verify the applicant meets the minimum 17 qualifications as established by the board. Additionally, Iin making such 18 19 appointment to entry-level positions, the appointing authority shall give a preference to Louisiana residents. If any one or more persons so certified should refuse the 20 21 appointment, the appointing authority shall then select and appoint any one of the remaining persons certified by the board or the state examiner. This procedure shall 22 be followed until the position has been filled by appointment of one of the persons 23 certified from the list and willing to accept the appointment, or until each person 24 25 whose name appears upon the list has in this manner been certified for the vacancy. 26

28 <u>Except for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer</u>, Fthe board
 29 shall establish and maintain lists containing names of persons eligible for

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(5) Any person whose name is placed upon the competitive employment list
for the entrance or lowest ranking class in the classified service who has served in
the armed forces of the United States of America during time of war, and who has
been honorably discharged or discharged under honorable conditions, shall have
added to his final test score a total of five points at the time of placing his name upon
the list. Proof of such service and discharge shall be required by the board <u>or state</u>
<u>examiner</u> in any manner it deems advisable.

11(9)(a) For purposes of entry level firefighter and entry level police12officer, the state examiner shall establish and maintain a statewide eligibility list13containing the names of persons eligible for appointment to these classes by any14municipality, parish, or fire protection district under the municipal fire and15police civil service system.

- 16 (b) A person who has attained a passing score on an examination administered by the state examiner for entrance police officer, entrance firefighter, 17 entrance jailer, secretary to the chief, departmental records clerk, or for the entrance 18 19 classes for which the operation and maintenance of radio, alarm, or signal systems for the respective fire or police services is the primary duty may have his name 20 21 placed on the employment list of any municipality, parish, or fire protection district 22 under the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service System, provided the person's application and score are accepted by the board of the municipality, parish, or fire 23 protection district in which he seeks employment. In order that his name may be 24 placed upon the employment eligibility list, a person shall be required to meet the 25 minimum qualifications adopted as rules of the respective civil service board, as if 26 27 making original application for admission to the test. The eligibility of such an 28 applicant shall not continue past the date on which his original eligibility expired.

Tests

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2 Tests to determine the eligibility of applicants for entry upon the promotional
3 and competitive employment lists shall be provided, as follows:

(1)(a) Except for entrance firefighter and entrance policer officer, Tthe 4 5 board shall provide through the state examiner for promotional or competitive tests. Official notice of examination shall be posted on the bulletin board in each station 6 7 of the respective department. The notice shall state (i) class of positions for which 8 tests will be given, (ii) whether the tests will be given on a promotional or 9 competitive basis, and (iii) the final date on which applications for admission to the 10 tests will be received. The notice shall be posted for a continuous period of thirty ten 11 days preceding the date for administering the tests.

12 (b) In addition to the posted notice, public notice for all tests to be given on 13 a competitive basis shall be published at least four times during the thirty-day period 14 in the official journal of the municipality, parish, or fire protection district, as the 15 case may be, during the ten-day period on the state examiner's website and the 16 municipality, parish, or fire protection district's website, if available, in which such tests are to be held. This notice of examination need not state the exact date on 17 which tests shall be administered, but all applicants shall be advised of the date, 18 19 place, and time to report for an announced test at least five days in advance thereof 20 in any manner the board may prescribe.

21 (c) For entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, the state 22 examiner shall publish notice on his website for ten-day notice of the location for where such tests are to be held and the final date on which applications for 23 24 admission to the test will be received. This notice of examination shall reveal the 25 exact date on which the test shall be administered. However, all applicants shall be advised of the place and time to report for an announced test at least five 26 27 days in advance in any manner the state examiner may prescribe. The state 28 examiner shall provide for online entrance firefighter and entrance police 29 testing as provided for in this Section by Fiscal Year 2022.

Upon the appointing authority's request for the 18 19 certification of eligible persons from which it may fill a vacancy, and if the competitive list is the appropriate list from which the names of eligible persons shall 20 be certified, the board or the state examiner shall certify the names of the persons 21 upon that list, in the order in which they appear thereon, for the class in which the 22 vacancy is to be filled. The appointing authority shall select and appoint to the first 23 24 vacancy to be filled any one of the persons so certified to it for the vacancy. In making appointments to entrance firefighter and entrance police officer, the 25 appointing authority shall verify the applicant meets the minimum 26 27 qualifications as established by the board. Additionally, Iin making such appointment to entry-level positions, the appointing authority shall give a preference 28 29 to Louisiana residents. If any one or more persons so certified refuses the

<u>Present law</u> provides that the municipal fire and police civil service boards establish and maintain employment lists of persons eligible for appointment to the positions of entry-level firefighter and police officer.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the office of the state examiner shall establish and maintain a statewide employment list of persons eligible for appointment to the positions of entry-level firefighter and police officer by any municipality, parish, or fire protection district under the municipal fire and police civil service system.

<u>Present law</u> provides that public notice of tests to determine the eligibility of entry-level firefighter and police officer applicants be posted for 30 days preceding the date for administering the test and that all tests to be given on a competitive basis will be published at least four times in the official journal of the municipality during that 30-day period.

<u>Proposed law</u> reduces the posting period in <u>present law</u> from 30 days to 10 days and requires the notice to be posted on the state examiner's website and the municipality's website, if available, during the 10-day period.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer tests, the state examiner will publish a 10-day notice on the office's website revealing the location where the test will be administered and the final date on which applications for admission to the test will be received. The notice will provide the exact date on which the test will be administered, and all applicants will be advised of the time and place to report for an announced test at least five days in advance in any manner the state examiner may prescribe.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the state examiner will provide for online entrance firefighter and police officer testing by Fiscal Year 2022.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the state examiner may call for and administer examinations for entrance classifications of firefighter, police officer, jailer, and for the entrance classes for positions of which the operation and maintenance of a radio, alarm, or signal system for the fire or police service is the primary duty.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the provisions of <u>present law</u> and provides for the state examiner to also administer examinations for entrance classifications for the positions of secretary to the chief and departmental records clerk.

<u>Present law</u> provides that whenever the appointing authority proposes to fill a vacancy in the classified service for entrance firefighter, entrance police officer, and other classified service

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positions, the municipal fire or police board will certify the list of eligible persons.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the state examiner will certify the list of eligible persons whenever the appointing authority proposes to fill a vacancy for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer positions and that the appointing authority will verify the applicant meets the minimum qualifications.

Effective January 1, 2021.

(Amends R.S. 33:2491(intro para), (E), and (I), 2492(1), (2), and (11), 2494(A) and (D), 2551(intro para), (5), and (9), 2552(1), (2), and (11), 2553(C), and 2554(A) and (D))

- 1. Places the responsibility for establishing and maintaining employment lists, testing and certification and eligibility for entrance firefighter and entrance police officer positions with the state examiner instead of the local fire and police civil service board.
