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Requires the uniform reporting by entities that assess, collect, or receive revenue from pre- or post-adjudication costs, fines, and fees

Proposes to create uniform reporting procedures for all local and state auditees relative to the assessment, collection, and distribution of fines and fees with the judicial system. These new reporting standards will provide a more complete and accurate understanding of judicial finances and the costs of operating the judicial system in the state of Louisiana.

Effective August 1, 2020.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The proposed law will increase the workload of certain state and local entities that assess, collect, or receive pre or post adjudication costs, fine, and fees. These entities include, but are not limited to, Clerks of Court, Sheriff's departments, District Attorneys' offices, and city courts. The workload will vary by parish, locality, and agency; however, these additional tasks will be performed utilizing existing resources and personnel. The Louisiana Supreme Court and the Legislative Auditor's office will also see a slight increase in workload but will be performed by current personnel.
