<u>Present law</u> provides that any "mandatory reporter", as defined by <u>present law</u>, who has cause to believe that a child's physical or mental health or welfare is endangered as a result of abuse or neglect, or that abuse or neglect was a contributing factor in a child's death, must report that suspected abuse to the proper authorities in accordance with <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that, for purposes of the reporting requirements of <u>present</u> <u>law</u>, the pregnancy of a child under the age of 13 years constitutes cause to believe that the child has been abused.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
