<u>Present law</u> provides a mechanism for businesses to transfer abandoned property to the state treasurer, requires abandoned property to be reported when it has a value of fifty dollars or more, and requires the treasurer (as administrator of unclaimed property) to advertise the name and address or location of an owner of unclaimed property having a total value of greater than fifty dollars. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the threshold requiring the treasurer to advertise unclaimed property from fifty to one hundred dollars.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an SGF expenditure decrease for the Treasury of approximately \$35,000. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the threshold for advertising unclaimed property from \$50 to \$100. The treasury reports that it may spend an estimated \$35,000 less on the statutorily required public notice for unclaimed properties in this value range.
