- 10 On page 1, delete lines 6 through 11 in their entirety and insert the following:

"Section 1. R.S. 38:2211(A)(14) and 2248(C) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
 §2211. Definitions

- A. As used in this Chapter unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
  following terms shall mean:
  \* \* \*
- 16 (14) "Liquidated Damages" means a fixed sum of damages stipulated in a public
   17 works construction contract that are intended to compensate a public entity as a result of a
   18 delay in performance by the contractor and may be assessed for a project not being
   19 substantially complete within the time provided for by the public works contract.

- \$2248. Provisions for withholding payment; effect on liability of contractor or agency;
   punch list; liquidated damages
   \* \* \*
- C. A public entity letting a public works construction contract, as per the terms of
   the contract, may withhold liquidated damages from any payments or monies otherwise due
   to the contractor, taking into consideration all granted time extensions."
