Amendments proposed by House Committee on Commerce to Original House Bill No. 812
by Representative Dustin Miller

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "meets;" delete "to provide for satisfaction of requirements;" and
3 insert in lieu thereof "to provide for a contingent effective date;"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 22 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

6 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective if and when the Class Action Settlement
7 Agreement in the lawsuit Soileau v. Churchill Downs La. Horseracing Co., Parish of
8 Orleans, Civil District Court, Division G, No. 2014-3873, is approved by the Court and
9 becomes final and non-appealable. Contingent upon this approval, as confirmed by a final
10 and non-appealable judgment, any amounts of purses from net video draw poker device
11 revenue collected but not yet distributed on the date the amended statute is made effective
12 shall be allocated and distributed according to the amended statute, using the same formula
13 provided therein."
