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Provides relative to the capital outlay application process. (8/1/20)

The <u>current law</u> requires the application for any capital outlay budget request which funding in the capital outlay budget be updated each year that the project remains active in the budget process to reflect all changes in the project that occurred since the previous submission. The <u>proposed legislation</u> limits the current law annual reapplication requirement to those projects that are receiving new state funding that are included in the capital outlay budget.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure since the proposed law limits the annual reapplication requirement to those projects that are receiving state funding to be included in the capital outlay budget. According to the DOA Office of Facility Planning & Control, this will reduce the number of capital outlay requests from entities and require staff to make copies of prior year requests for projects that need to be in the capital outlay bill to cover outstanding commitments and/or expenditures.
