6 the core subject areas of English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies shall  
7 be purchased unless it is determined to be aligned with state content standards through the  
8 review process conducted in accordance with R.S. 17:351.1. No digital content or  
9 curriculum designed to teach career and technical education may be purchased from a  
10 provider unless the provider is authorized as a course provider by the State Board of  
11 Elementary and Secondary Education in accordance with R.S. 17:4002.4."

13 On page 2, line 18, after "fund" and before "to" delete "on a first come, first-served basis"

15 On page 2, at the beginning of line 28, delete "performance"
