1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, change "37:1739" to "29:773"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 14, and insert the following:

10 **"A. A governmental entity which is in substantial compliance with**
11 **Proclamation Number 25 JBE 2020 and any subsequent related**
12 **proclamations and associated guidelines issued by the Center for Disease**
13 **Control, shall not have civil liability for injury or death due to COVID-19**
14 **infection transmitted through an alleged exposure occurring on its premises**
15 **or through the services provided by the governmental entity during the**
16 **COVID-19 public health emergency as declared by Proclamation Number 25**
17 **JBE 2020, unless the injury or death was caused by gross negligence or**
18 **willful and wanton misconduct."**

19 AMENDMENT NO. 5

20 On page 1, delete lines 15 through 17, and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 3, and insert
21 the following:

22 **"B. For the purpose of this Section, "governmental entity" means the state,**
23 **all agencies, boards,"**

24 AMENDMENT NO. 6

25 On page 2, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

26 "Section 2. Due to the imminent threat posed by COVID-19 as provided in
27 Proclamation Number 25 JBE 2020 and any subsequent related proclamations, declaring
28 the existence of a statewide public health emergency, Section 1 of this Act shall be
29 retroactive to March 11, 2020."

30 AMENDMENT NO. 7

31 On page 2, line 7, "Section 2." to "Section 3."
