

1 insurance coverage in order to enroll in Medicaid, costing the program in excess of one
2 hundred forty-five million dollars per year; and

3 WHEREAS, a request by the legislature for regular reports on the problem of crowd-
4 out in Louisiana Medicaid would serve the interest of greater transparency in that program
5 and facilitate a better understanding of the true costs and impacts of the problem.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
7 urge and request the Louisiana Department of Health to collect data on Medicaid enrollees
8 with private insurance or offers of employer-sponsored health coverage.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana Department of Health shall obtain
10 such data by inquiring with potential Medicaid enrollees about their private health insurance
11 status and participation in, or offers of, employer-sponsored insurance at both the time of
12 their application and the time of their eligibility redetermination.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on or before November 1, 2020, and quarterly
14 thereafter, the Louisiana Department of Health shall report such data to the House
15 Committee on Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Finance, the House Committee on
16 Health and Welfare, the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, and the David R. Poynter
17 Legislative Research Library.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the first report due pursuant to this Resolution
19 shall feature data from the first quarter of State Fiscal Year 2020-2021, and the ensuing
20 quarterly reports shall cover subsequent State Fiscal Year quarters.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislative authority for the request provided for
22 in this Resolution shall terminate on August 1, 2022.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
24 secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health.
