15	"(2)(a) The statewide public health emergency caused by
16	COVID-19 has left a staggering statewide economic impact on
17	Louisiana industries, including but not limited to oilfields,
18	manufacturing, agriculture, restaurant and food and beverage services,
19	education services, places of public amusement, personal care and
20	grooming services, gyms and fitness centers, and retail stores, which has
21	led to a devastating effect on many small businesses and the Louisiana
22	residents employed in the various industries.
23	(b) To support the Louisiana residents employed in the affected
24	industries who have experienced layoffs and furloughs that have
25	significantly reduced their income and thereby put them in a position to
26	have to prioritize which of their families' basic needs, such as food,
27	<u>healthcare, housing payments, insurance, or utilities, they can meet with</u>
28	their income limited as a result of COVID-19, no insurer shall set an
29	insurance rate or classify any risk on the basis of the insured's
30	<u>employment type or job classification.</u>
31	(c) The provisions of this Paragraph shall not apply to workers'
32	<u>compensation policies.</u>
33	(d) The provisions of this Paragraph shall be null, void, and of no
34	effect on and after August 1, 2023."
