30 center."

2 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 8 in their entirety.

3 AMENDMENT NO. 134 On page 3, at the beginning of line 9, change "C." to "B."5 AMENDMENT NO. 14

6 On page 3, delete lines 10 through 15 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

7 "the department, through its contracts with managed care organizations, shall
 8 prohibit an out-of-region nonemergency, non-ambulance medical transportation
 9 provider from providing services to a Medicaid enrollee if there is a willing and
 10 available nonemergency, non-ambulance medical transportation provider in the
 11 region where the Medicaid enrollee is domiciled. The department shall provide in
 12 rule for the boundaries of the regions which apply to this Subsection and for
 13 penalties for providers which violate the out-of-region service prohibition established
 14 by this Paragraph."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 15

16 On page 3, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

17 "§460.102. Partnership for support of nonemergency, non-ambulance medical
 18 transportation industry

19 The department may partner or otherwise enter into a formal relationship
 20 with an association to accomplish the following:

21 (1) Promote uniformity to the nonemergency, non-ambulance medical
 22 transportation industry.

23 (2) Set standards that elevate quality and trusted service.

24 (3) Provide opportunities for training and business counseling.

25 (4) Maintain a vetted, updated list of active nonemergency, non-ambulance
 26 medical transportation providers.

27 (5) Develop a platform for all that work within the nonemergency, non-
 28 ambulance medical transportation industry or utilize nonemergency medical
 29 transportation services to receive the latest news and trends affecting the
 30 nonemergency, non-ambulance medical transportation industry."
