Relative to security for deposit of funds

Present law requires state depositing authorities to require security for deposit of state funds into fiscal agent banks and provides for definitions. Proposed law expands the types of collateral that a state depositing authority may accept from a fiscal agent bank to include: 1) any obligation, security or investment that the state may invest in directly under R.S. 49:327, 2) state bonds, debentures, notes, or other indebtedness of a certain minimum credit rating issued by a state other than Louisiana or such state's political subdivisions, and 3) bonds, debentures, notes, or other indebtedness of a certain minimum credit rating issued by domestic U.S. corporations. Proposed law provides that notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, there shall be no duration limitation or restriction on the bonds used as security pursuant to present and proposed law.
