Expands the authorized uses of monies in the State Emergency Response Fund

Present law establishes the State Emergency Response Fund (SERF) to provide a source of funds for the preparation for and response to declared disasters and emergencies. Proposed law expands the authorized uses of SERF monies to recovery from a declared disaster or emergency, and authorizes SERF monies to be used for specified cybersecurity related activities and to respond to cyber incidents.
