SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Provides for the boundaries of the Baton Rouge North Economic Development District. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:2740.67(B), relative to Baton Rouge North Economic  
3 Development District; to provide relative to the boundaries of the district; and to  
4 provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 33:2740.67(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

8 §2740.67. Baton Rouge North Economic Development District

9 \* \* \*

10 B. Boundaries. The district shall include the area within the following  
11 boundaries: beginning at the intersection of North 22nd Street and Florida  
12 Boulevard, east along Florida Boulevard to its intersection with North Sherwood  
13 Forest Drive, then north along North Sherwood Forest Drive to its intersection with  
14 Greenwell Springs Road, then southwest along Greenwell Springs Road to its  
15 intersection with Joor Road, then north along Joor Road to its intersection with  
16 Mickens Road, then west along Mickens Road to its intersection with Hooper Road,  
17 then west along Hooper Road to its intersection with Harding Boulevard, continuing

1 west along Harding Boulevard to its intersection with Veterans Memorial Boulevard,  
 2 then north along Veterans Memorial Boulevard to its intersection with Rosenwald  
 3 Road, then west along Rosenwald Road to its intersection with Scenic Highway, then  
 4 south along Scenic Highway to its intersection with **Shada Avenue, then west to the**  
 5 **Mississippi River levee, then south along the Mississippi River levee to Choctaw**  
 6 **Drive, then east along Choctaw Drive to its intersection with Scenic Highway,**  
 7 **then south along Scenic Highway to its intersection with** Main Street, then east  
 8 along Main Street to its intersection with North 22nd Street, then south along North  
 9 22nd Street to the point of beginning.

11 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
 12 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
 13 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
 14 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
 15 effective on the day following such approval.

Present law provides for the following boundaries of the Baton Rouge North Economic Development District: beginning at the intersection of North 22nd Street and Florida Boulevard, east along Florida Boulevard to its intersection with North Sherwood Forest Drive, then north along North Sherwood Forest Drive to its intersection with Greenwell Springs Road, then southwest along Greenwell Springs Road to its intersection with Joor Road, then north along Joor Road to its intersection with Mickens Road, then west along Mickens Road to its intersection with Hooper Road, then west along Hooper Road to its intersection with Harding Boulevard, continuing west along Harding Boulevard to its intersection with Veterans Memorial Boulevard, then north along Veterans Memorial Boulevard to its intersection with Rosenwald Road, then west along Rosenwald Road to its intersection with Scenic Highway, then south along Scenic Highway to its intersection with Main Street, then east along Main Street to its intersection with North 22nd Street, then south along North 22nd Street to the point of beginning.

Proposed law retains present law but expands the boundaries of the Baton Rouge North Economic Development District to include the area within the following boundaries: beginning at the intersection of Scenic Highway and Shada Avenue, then west to the Mississippi River levee, then south along the Mississippi River levee to Choctaw Drive, then east along Choctaw Drive to its intersection with Scenic Highway, then south along Scenic Highway to its intersection with Main Street.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
