



1 have serious concerns about how contact tracing will impact their liberty, right to privacy,  
2 and other basic rights.

3 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
4 direct the governor to ensure that the liberty and individual rights of the citizens of this state  
5 are protected as the state administers the public health function known as contact tracing.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct  
7 the governor to require that the personnel who conduct contact tracing disclose to all persons  
8 whom they contact that participation in contact tracing is entirely voluntary before  
9 requesting any information from those persons.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct  
11 the governor not to authorize or otherwise impose any penalty for refusal by a person to  
12 participate in contact tracing.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct  
14 the governor to strictly prohibit all of the following:

15 (1) Tracking of any person's movements through mobile phone geolocation or any  
16 other means, electronic or otherwise, in contact tracing.

17 (2) Any data mining that would facilitate the tracking of a person's movements.

18 (3) The collection of personal identifying information through contact tracing.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct  
20 the governor to give absolute assurance to the people of this state that contact tracing will  
21 not entail the compulsory separation of family members or the prohibition of willing  
22 association among individuals.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct  
24 the governor not to authorize or otherwise impose any mandate that any individual be tested  
25 for the novel coronavirus or antibodies to the virus.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
27 governor and to the secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health.
