<u>Present law</u> requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to identify a transition specialist at each of the state correctional facilities who shall perform certain duties which include furnishing a photo identification card to an offender prior to his release.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds that, to the extent funding is available, the offender shall also be issued a card that includes a list of all vocational licensing and certification programs completed by the offender while incarcerated.

Effective August 1, 2020.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of</u> <u>Criminal Justice</u> to the <u>engrossed</u> bill:
- 1. Remove the <u>proposed law</u> provision which required the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue a photo identification card that includes a list of all licensing and certification programs completed by the offender.
- 2. Add that, to the extent funding is available, the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections shall issue a card to the offender that includes a list of all vocational licensing and certification programs completed by the offender.
