- 5 On page 1, line 3, change "amend" to "provide relative to"
- 6 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 7 On page 1, line 4, after "manslaughter;" and before "and" insert "to provide relative to a 8 continuous sequence of events resulting in the death of a human being;"
- 9 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
 11 14:30.1(A)(5) and 31(A)(3) are hereby enacted to"
- 12 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 5</u>
- 13 On page 1, delete lines 12 through 19 in their entirety and insert the following:
- 14 "(5) When the offender commits or attempts to commit first degree rape, 15 second degree rape, aggravated arson, aggravated burglary, aggravated kidnapping, 16 second degree kidnapping, aggravated escape, assault by drive-by shooting, armed 17 robbery, first degree robbery, second degree robbery, simple robbery, cruelty to 18 juveniles, second degree cruelty to juveniles, or terrorism, which is part of a 19 continuous sequence of events resulting in the death of a human being where it was foreseeable that the offender's conduct during the commission of the crime could 20 21 result in death or great bodily harm to a human being, even if the offender has no 22 intent to kill or to inflict great bodily harm. For purposes of this Paragraph, it shall be immaterial whether or not the person who performed the direct act resulting in the 23 death was acting in concert with the offender." 24
- 25 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- 26 On page 2, delete lines 4 through 6 in their entirety and insert the following:
- 27 "(3) When the offender commits or attempts to commit any crime of violence as defined by R.S. 14:2(B) that is not enumerated in R.S. 14:30 or 30.1, 28 29 which is part of a continuous sequence of events resulting in the death of a human 30 being where it was foreseeable that the offender's conduct during the commission of 31 the crime could result in death or great bodily harm to a human being, even if the 32 offender has no intent to kill or to inflict great bodily harm. For purposes of this 33 Paragraph, it shall be immaterial whether or not the person who performed the direct 34 act resulting in the death was acting in concert with the offender."
