1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 5, at the beginning of line 12, after "<u>A.</u>" insert "(1)"
- 3 <u>AMENDMENT NO. 2</u>
- 4 On page 5, between lines 27 and 28, insert the following:

5 "(2) In the event of an emergency caused by attack, disaster, or public health 6 emergency, the presiding officers of the legislature may convene the legislature in 7 an emergency session without prior notice if the presiding officers deem it 8 appropriate and necessary to respond to the emergency."

- 9 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 10 On page 6, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:

11 "C. At a session convened pursuant to Subsection A of this Section or at any 12 session in operation at the inception of an attack or certain declared disasters or public health emergencies, the legislature may enact temporary law by concurrent 13 14 resolution which shall fix the period of effectiveness which shall not extend beyond 15 one year and sixty days. Such a resolution shall not be subject to deadlines for prefiling, introduction, or final passage; subject matter limitations; committee 16 hearing or report; or gubernatorial veto; however, it shall be subject to the same vote 17 18 requirements for the passage of that law in the manner provided for in R.S. 24:73."
