PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT. Provides relative to the photo identification issued to an offender prior to his release. (8/1/20)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Removes the provisions requiring the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to issue a photo identification card that includes a list of all licensing and certification programs completed by the offender.
2. Adds that, to the extent funding is available, the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections shall issue a card to the offender that includes a list of all vocational licensing and certification programs completed by the offender.

Present law requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to identify a transition specialist at each of the state correctional facilities who shall perform certain duties which include furnishing a photo identification card to an offender prior to his release.

Proposed law retains present law and adds that, to the extent funding is available, the offender shall also be issued a card that includes a list of all vocational licensing and certification programs completed by the offender while incarcerated.

Effective August 1, 2020.
