HB 676 2020 Regular Session Emerson

HIGHER EDUCATION: Prohibits a public postsecondary education institution from withholding certain student services for financial reasons

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes <u>proposed law</u> applicable to public postsecondary education institutions.
- 2. Changes <u>proposed law from a prohibition on certain actions by institutions to</u> an authorization for public postsecondary education management boards to prohibit such actions.
- 3. Provides that management board policies may prohibit debt repayment plan enrollment as a requirement for obtaining a transcript.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Proposed law</u> provides relative to current and former students who are in default on a federal loan.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes public postsecondary education management boards to adopt policies to prohibit the institutions under their supervision and management from doing any of the following because of student debt:

- (1) Withhold release of records, including transcripts, grades, and diplomas.
- (2) Condition providing a transcript on:
 - (a) Debt payment other than fee charged for a transcript.
 - (b) Requiring a current or former student to enter into a debt repayment plan.
- (3) Charge a higher fee for a transcript, or otherwise treat a student less favorably than a student without a debt.
- (4) Withhold a transcript as a tool for debt collection.
