Amendments proposed by Senator Cloud to Engrossed House Bill No. 869 by Representative Carrier

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Floor Amendment No. 7 proposed by Senator Lambert and adopted by the  
3 Senate on June 1, 2020.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, delete line 6 in its entirety and insert the following:

6 "§2154. Powers; duties; restrictions; prohibitions; penalties

7 \* \* \*

8 C.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, the  
9 secretary ~~shall not~~ may only issue any permit ~~or promulgate any rule or regulation~~  
10 which would allow the construction or operation of a medical waste incinerator  
11 disposal facility of any type ~~in this state until such rules and regulations are~~  
12 ~~specifically authorized by law.~~

13 ~~(2) The prohibition in this Subsection shall not apply to the regulation or~~  
14 ~~permitting of any such facility possessing a permit or interim permit on April 16,~~  
15 ~~1990 nor to an application which was pending and had not been denied prior to July~~  
16 ~~1, 1990.~~

17 ~~(3) In no event shall any such permit be issued without in parishes with a~~  
18 ~~population below fifty thousand according to the latest federal decennial census. In~~  
19 ~~such parishes, a permit may be only issued after prior notification of legislators~~  
20 ~~representing the area which includes the site of the facility, or the proposed site of~~  
21 ~~the facility and after a prior public hearing in that area.~~

22 ~~(4) (2) The department shall promulgate necessary rules and regulations, in~~  
23 ~~accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, for the permitting of medical~~  
24 ~~waste incinerator disposal facilities within one hundred eighty days after being~~  
25 ~~specifically authorized by law.~~

27 Section 2. R.S. 30:2180(D)(4) is hereby repealed in its entirety."
