<u>Prior law</u> provided for definitions relative to the Health Care Consumer Billing and Disclosure Protection Act.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and adds to the definition of "noncovered health care services" care services or products excluded from <u>prior law</u> pursuant to an advance written agreement by the enrollee or insured concerning specific payment terms when authorized by <u>prior law</u>.

Prior law provided for exceptions to prior law.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and adds vision coverage to a health insurance contract or plan delivered in this state should a patient receive a diagnosis from a contracted provider for which the patient qualifies for covered service pursuant to the patient's health plan.

Effective August 1, 2020.
