Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 6 by Representative Ivey

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 6, before "provide for" insert "provide for the powers  
3 and duties of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget and the Joint Legislative  
4 Committee on Technology and Cybersecurity; to provide restrictions on use of the monies;  
5 to"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, line 17, change "thirty-five hundredths" to "one hundredth"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 2, delete lines 9 through 15 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

10 "C.(1) Monies in the fund may only be expended on projects approved by  
11 the Joint Legislative Committee on Technology and Cybersecurity, or its successor.  
12 (2) No later than October 1, 2022, and October first each year thereafter, the  
13 office of technology services shall provide a proposed list of projects for the coming  
14 fiscal year to the Joint Legislative Committee on Technology and Cybersecurity.  
15 (3) The committee shall hold public meetings for the purpose of reviewing  
16 priorities for the coming fiscal year.  
17 (4) At each public meeting, the office of technology services shall provide  
18 the committee with the following details on each proposed project:  
19 (a) The total projected cost.  
20 (b) Whether federal funds are available to help fund all or a portion of the  
21 project.  
22 (c) The projected time line for completion.  
23 (5) No later than January first of each year, the committee shall submit a list  
24 of recommended projects to the speaker of the House of Representatives, the  
25 president of the Senate, the chairman of the House Committee on Appropriations and  
26 the chairman of the Senate Committee on Finance.  
27 (6) The Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget shall meet no later than  
28 January thirty-first of each year to approve the Joint Legislative Committee on  
29 Technology and Cybersecurity's project recommendations and allocate monies from  
30 the fund for the approved projects. Approval shall require a majority vote of the  
31 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. Prior to approval, the Joint Legislative  
32 Committee on the Budget may delete projects from the recommendation list. In no  
33 event shall it add any projects to the list, nor shall it make substitutions for projects  
34 which have been removed without approval from the Joint Legislative Committee  
35 on Technology and Cybersecurity."
