Abstract: Requires the Occupational Forecasting Conference to develop and produce a short-term occupational forecast report that solely focuses on the impact of COVID-19.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that notwithstanding any other provisions of <u>proposed law</u>, a short-term forecast to account for the economic shifts resulting from the global COVID-19 pandemic shall be derived and approved by the Occupational Forecasting Conference.

<u>Proposed law provides</u> that the short-term COVID-19-affected forecast shall require quantitative data from various sources, surveys, and information from the Louisiana Workforce Commission and Louisiana Economic Development, and the input of regional economic development organizations.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the conference shall derive and approve of a second and third short-term COVID-19-affected forecast.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the first short-term COVID-19-affected forecast required by <u>proposed</u> law shall be produced and released publicly by September 30, 2020.

<u>Proposed law provides that the second short-term COVID-19-affected forecast required by proposed law</u> shall be produced and released publicly by March 31, 2021.

<u>Proposed law provides that the third short-term COVID-19-affected forecast required by proposed law shall be produced and released publicly by September 30, 2021.</u>

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
