As used in Subsection A of this Section, "cyber incident" means an 14 event that may jeopardize the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of digital 15 information or information systems. 16 Section 2. 3	A. The clerk of court shall notify the secretary of state, or his designee,
4	by telephone, electronic mail, or facsimile within twenty-four hours following
5	the discovery of a cyber incident that impacts the office of the clerk of court
6	related to any computer system connected to or maintained by the secretary of
7	state.
8	B. As used in Subsection A of this Section, "cyber incident" means an
9	event that may jeopardize the confidentiality, integrity, or availability of digital
10	information or information systems.
