Suspends certain provisions of law relative to direct actions against insurers. (Item #40)

LIABILITY INSURANCE OR NO IMPACT See Note

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Present law provides for insurers to obtain a certificate of authority, which requires them to consent to being sued by an injured person or their heirs through direction action for injuries occurring in LA. Present law provides for direction action against an insurers if one of the following applies: the insured is adjuged bankrupt by a court of competition jurisdiction, or proceedings have been commenced for such; the insured is insolvent; service of citation or other process cannot be made on the insured; the cause of action is for damages from an offense/quasi-offense between children and parents or married persons; the insurer is an uninsured motorist carrier; the insured is deceased. Proposed resolution suspends the preceding present law through the 60th day of the 2021 Regular Session.
