MENTAL HEALTH: Requests a study by the respective legislative committees to study the rights of caregivers and the establishment of a "caregivers' bill of rights" for family members, legal guardians, and other persons who provide care for persons with serious mental illness

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Requests rather than directs the legislative committees to conduct the study.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Requests the House Committee on Health and Welfare, the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, the House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure, and the Senate Committee on Judiciary A, or a subcommittee thereof, to meet and to study the adequacy of rights afforded to caregivers and the effects of establishing a "caregivers' bill of rights" for family members, legal guardians, and other persons who provide care for persons with serious mental illness and to report their findings no later than February 1, 2021.
