(C) Notwithstanding any provision of this Act, any Capital Outlay Act, or any provision of law to the contrary, the appropriations included herein and in House Bill No. 2 of the 2020 First Extraordinary Session with capital outlay budget requests for projects with appropriations payable from State General Fund (Direct) Non-Recurring Revenues or payable from General Obligation Bonds for Fiscal Year 2020-2021, shall be considered to be submitted timely if received no later than June 30, 2020, and are otherwise compliant with the provisions of R.S. 39:101 and R.S. 39:102. Such capital outlay budget requests together with the supporting information and documents for such projects shall constitute the feasability study required by Article VII, Section 11(C) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
