Existing law requires each parish governing authority to appoint a registrar of voters who is responsible for the registration of voters in the parish.

Existing law requires a registrar of voters to file an oath of office and a bond for the faithful performance of duties with specified officials. Existing law requires that the registrar file the oath with the clerk of court and the secretary of state.

Prior law required that the registrar file the oath and the bond with the state treasurer.

New law removes the requirement that the registrar file the oath of office with the treasurer and requires that he file the bond for the faithful performance of duties with the secretary of state.

Effective Aug. 1, 2020.
