<u>New law</u> requires Louisiana to adopt daylight saving time year round, when the federal law is amended to allow it.

<u>New law</u> provides that, if <u>new law</u> becomes effective when the state is observing daylight saving time, the state shall not return to the observance of standard time.

<u>New law</u> provides that, if <u>new law</u> becomes effective when the state is observing standard time, then the state shall wait until 2:00 a.m. on the second Sunday in March to return to, and remain in, the observance of daylight saving time.
