Existing law provides requirements and conditions relating to disclosure of records by the state registrar of vital records.

New law adds a requirement that the state registrar issue the following records to the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) upon the written request of an office of the department:

- (1) A certified copy of a birth certificate of a child placed in the custody of DCFS.
- (2) A certified copy of a death certificate of a child who was in the custody of DCFS at the time of his death.
- (3) A certified copy of a death certificate of a parent of a child placed in the custody of DCFS.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 5, 2020).
