**Abstract:** Provides for civil and criminal liability immunity for religious assembly during declared public emergencies.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that no natural or juridical person shall be subject to civil or criminal liability for assembling for religious purposes during a declared public emergency, including public health emergencies.

Proposed law is retroactive to March 11, 2020.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
