 3 "the procedure provided by in" and insert "in accordance with"

 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

 5 On page 1, delete lines 18 through 20 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 11 and insert the
 6 following:

 7 "B.(1) The legislature, in consultation with the public health authority, by a
 8 petition signed by a majority of the surviving members of either house, may
 9 terminate a state of public health emergency at any time. This petition terminating
 10 the public health emergency may establish a period during which no other
 11 declaration of public health emergency may be issued. Thereupon, the governor
 12 shall issue an executive order or proclamation ending the state of public health or
 13 emergency. The House of Representatives or the Senate may terminate a state of
 14 public health emergency at any time by a petition signed by the majority of its
 15 surviving members. The petition may establish and confine the applicability of a
 16 period during which no other declaration of a public health emergency may be issued
 17 and shall include a date and time on which the state of public health emergency
 18 terminates. The petition shall be submitted to the clerical officer of the respective
 19 house. Upon receipt of a valid petition, the clerical officer shall transmit copies of
 20 the signed petition to the other house, the governor, and the secretary of state. The
 21 clerical officer shall give notice to the public of the termination of the state of public
 22 health emergency by publishing the petition on the joint legislative website and in
 23 the official journal of the state. No additional action is required to effectuate the
 24 termination of the state of public health emergency."
