### 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

# On page 3, line 24, change "<u>The</u>" to "<u>Subject to the provisions of Paragraph (5) of this</u> <u>Subsection, the</u>"

#### 10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 4, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

12	"(5) Immediately upon receipt of the notification from the governor as
13	provided in Paragraph (3) of this Subsection, the clerk of the House of
14	Representatives and the secretary of the senate shall jointly prepare and
15	transmit a ballot to each surviving member of the legislature as follows:
16	(a) The ballots shall be uniform.
17	(b) Each ballot shall contain a question phrased to allow each member
18	to cast his vote for or against the renewal of the state of disaster or emergency.
19	(c) Each ballot shall include a place for the member to whom the ballot
20	has been transmitted to provide his name and validate his ballot after casting
21	his vote.
22	(d) The clerk of the House of Representatives and the secretary of the
23	Senate shall transmit the ballots to all of the surviving members on the same
24	day. The clerk and the secretary shall certify this date, which is referred to in
25	this Paragraph as the "transmittal date".
26	(e) The clerk and the secretary shall provide a notice to each member
27	of the legislature on the transmittal date. The notice shall include all of the
28	<u>following:</u>
29	(i) The notification from the governor.
30	(ii) The date and time by which the ballot shall be returned to the
31	<u>clerical officer of the member's house in order to be valid.</u>
32	(iii) Such other pertinent information as the clerk and the secretary shall
33	determine.
34	(f) The member shall cast his vote, provide his name in the appropriate
35	place on the ballot, and return the voted ballot to the clerical officer of his
36	house.
37	(g) The clerk and the secretary shall provide notice to each member
38	from whom the clerk or the secretary, as applicable, receives a voted ballot
39	confirming that the ballot has been received.

1 (h) On the fourth day after the transmittal date, the clerk and the 2 secretary shall provide a notice to each member whose voted ballot has not been 3 received indicating that the member's voted ballot has not been received and 4 informing the member of the deadline for returning the ballot. 5 (i) Ballots shall be returned to the clerk and the secretary no later than 6 five o'clock p.m. on the fifth day after the transmittal date. 7 (j) No ballot received by the clerk and the secretary after the deadline 8 provided in Subparagraph (i) of this Paragraph shall be valid or counted, but 9 the day and time received shall be recorded for each ballot received after such 10 time, and the ballot shall be marked "Invalid". However, prior to the deadline 11 for returning a ballot, a member may withdraw his ballot or change his vote 12 upon his written request. 13 (k)(i) Whenever the clerk of the House of Representatives and the 14 secretary of the Senate are to transmit a ballot or notice to a member of the 15 legislature pursuant to this Paragraph, the ballot or notice shall be transmitted 16 using the most efficient medium available to the clerk or the secretary under the 17 circumstances and may include but is not limited to electronic mail or SMS 18 communications. Any such medium shall provide for notice of receipt and the 19 records of all such transmittals and notices shall be maintained and preserved 20 for a least six months following the tabulation. (ii) The clerk and the secretary shall devise a method for a member to 21 22 validate his ballot which may include signature, personal identification number, 23 or other secure method. 24 (l)(i) On the next business day after the deadline for returning ballots 25 as provided in Subparagraph (i) of this Paragraph, the clerk of the House of 26 Representatives and the secretary of the Senate shall tabulate the vote in roll 27 call order for each house of the legislature. The clerk and the secretary shall 28 hold such ballots under seal and shall not disclose the contents to any person 29 until the day when such ballots are tabulated. No ballot shall be deemed spoiled 30 if inadvertently disclosed in processing. 31 (ii) The tabulation shall indicate by name those members who voted for 32 the renewal, those who voted against the renewal, those returned a valid ballot 33 but who did not vote, those who did not return the ballot by the due date and 34 time, and those whose ballots were invalid because not validated by the 35 member. The clerk and the secretary shall sign the tabulation sheet or sheets 36 and cause a summary thereof to be transmitted to each member of the 37 legislature and the governor. Further, the clerk and the secretary shall 38 disseminate the tabulation promptly by means calculated to bring its contents 39 to the attention of the general public and promptly file it with the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness and with the 40 41 secretary of state. 42 (m)(i) If a majority of the surviving members of each house of the 43 legislature vote to approve the renewal then the governor may proceed with 44 issuing the order or proclamation to renew the state of disaster or emergency. 45 (ii) If a majority of the surviving members of each house of the 46 legislature do not approve the renewal, then the state of disaster or emergency 47 is deemed terminated as of the date and time the tabulation is transmitted to the 48 governor and the governor shall not issue another order or proclamation to 49 renew that state of disaster or emergency." 50 AMENDMENT NO. 4

53	using the most efficient medium available to the clerk or the secretary under the
54	circumstances and may include but is not limited to electronic mail or SMS

<u>communications. Any such medium shall provide for notice of receipt and the</u> <u>records of all such transmittals and notices shall be maintained and preserved</u> <u>for a least six months following the tabulation.</u>

(b) The clerk and the secretary shall devise a method for a member to validate his ballot which may include signature, personal identification number, or other secure method.

(10)(a) On the next business day after the deadline for returning ballots as provided in Paragraph (7) of this Subsection the clerk of the House of Representatives and the secretary of the Senate shall tabulate the vote in roll call order for each house of the legislature. The clerk and the secretary shall hold such ballots under seal and shall not disclose the contents to any person until the day when such ballots are tabulated. No ballot shall be deemed spoiled if inadvertently disclosed in processing.

14 (b) The tabulation shall indicate by name those members who voted to 15 approve the renewal, those who voted against the renewal, those returned a 16 valid ballot but who did not vote, those who did not return the ballot by the due 17 date and time, and those whose ballots were invalid because not validated by the 18 member. The clerk and the secretary shall sign the tabulation sheet or sheets 19 and cause a summary thereof to be transmitted to each member of the 20 legislature and the governor. Further, the clerk and the secretary shall 21 disseminate the tabulation promptly by means calculated to bring its contents 22 to the attention of the general public and promptly file it with the Governor's 23 Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness, with the secretary 24 of state, and with the Louisiana Department of Health, office of public health. 25 (11)(a) If a majority of the surviving members of each house of the 26 legislature vote to approve the renewal then the governor may proceed with 27 issuing the order or proclamation to renew the state of public health emergency. 28 (b) If a majority of the surviving members of each house of the

legislature do not approve the renewal, then the state of public health
 emergency is deemed terminated as of the date and time the tabulation is
 transmitted to the governor and the governor shall not issue another order or
 proclamation to renew that state of public health emergency."
