1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, change "and 3212" to "through 3214"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, delete line 5 and insert in lieu thereof "places of business; to provide for
5 exceptions; to limit liability; to provide for certain powers and duties; to provide for
6 applicability; and to provide for related matters."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 8, change "and 3212" to "through 3214"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, line 16, delete "an" and insert "a state-approved"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 2, line 5, after "organization" delete the remainder of the line and insert a comma
13 "," and "including but not limited to a bar, restaurant, casino, official gaming establishment,
14 other establishment providing gaming operations, or a financial institution that"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 2, line 8, after "services" insert a comma "," and "including educational services."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 2, line 14, after "identification" and before the comma "," insert "or age"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 8

20 On page 2, line 15, after "accept a" insert "state-issued"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 9

22 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 20 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

23 "(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Chapter to the contrary, a
24 federally insured depository institution shall not be required to accept a digitized
25 identification card as a valid form of identification. However, a federally insured
26 depository institution may, at its option, accept a digitized identification card as a
27 valid form of identification."

29 On page 2, line 22, delete "the" and insert "a state-approved"

30 AMENDMENT NO. 11

1 On page 3, line 1, after "identity" insert "or age"

2 AMENDMENT NO. 12

3 On page 3, after line 5, add the following:

4 "§3213. Powers and duties

5 The Louisiana Gaming Control Board and the office of alcohol and tobacco
6 control have authority to take actions, not inconsistent with law, as deemed necessary
7 to ensure a respective licensee's compliance with the provisions of this Chapter.

8 §3214. Applicability

9 The provisions of this Chapter do not apply to a location of business in the
10 state of Louisiana where a physical copy of an individual's current driver's license,
11 valid passport, or visa issued by the federal government or another country or nation,
12 or other card of identity is held in compliance with state or federal law."
