**Abstract:** Requires the state fire marshal to provide a form that businesses may use to describe the safety precautions they are employing during a public health emergency.

Proposed law requires the state fire marshal to provide a menu-styled form, which a business owner or operator may print and post, in order to communicate to the public the safety precautions being utilized during a declared public health emergency. Requires the form to be available on the state fire marshal website.

Proposed law describes the information the form is to contain.

Proposed law allows the operator to modify or remove the posted form at any time.

Proposed law shields an owner or operator from incurring liability as a result of the posted form.

Proposed law instructs the state fire marshal to promulgate rules necessary to implement proposed law.
