Luneau

Present law provides relative to the La. Employment Security Law and defines certain terms.

Proposed law retains present law.

SB 68 Original

<u>Proposed law</u> adds a definition for the term "employee". An "employee" means an individual who performs services for an employer where there exists a right by the employer to control what work the employee does or how the employee performs his job or where the employer provides the tools and supplies to the employee for the performance of the job.

Present law defines the term "employment" and provides for exceptions.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> definition of "employment" and the exceptions and adds that the term "employment" does not include individuals engaged in an independent trade, business, or profession in which he offers his services to the general public with the authority to control what will be done and how it will be done.

Effective January 1, 2021.
