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- Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
- 5 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

- 7 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 8 effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the issuance of permits by the La. Department of Health for retail food establishments.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that any applicant who obtained a permit that was effective on March 17, 2020, shall be eligible for one of the following:

- (1) Be exempt from payment of the next regularly scheduled permit renewal fee if the applicant's business establishment was required to temporarily cease retail operations pursuant to Proclamation Number 30 JBE 2020, or any subsequent proclamation declaring the existence of a statewide COVID-19 public health emergency.
- (2) Be issued a refund of the fee paid for the permit that was in effect if a permitted business establishment has permanently closed as a result of the mandate to temporarily cease retail operations pursuant to Proclamation Number 30 JBE 2020, or any subsequent proclamation declaring the existence of a statewide COVID-19 public health emergency.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
