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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, change "safety" to "mitigation"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line at the end of line 5, add "to provide for emergency orders;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 10, after "shall" insert a comma "," and "in consultation with the Louisiana  
7 Department of Health,"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, line 11, change "may" to "shall"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 1, line 12, change "safety" to "mitigation"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 1, line 17, after "the" delete "possible safety" and insert in lieu thereof  
14 "recommended mitigation"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 7

16 On page 2, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:

17 "(f) Reduced occupancy limits are observed.  
18 (g) No mitigation measures are being implemented."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 8

20 On page 2, line 6, after "is" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof  
21 "implementing."

22 AMENDMENT NO. 9

23 On page 2, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:

24 "C. The state fire marshal shall provide rules relative to the size and  
25 placement of the form, and the owner or operator shall post the form accordingly."

1 AMENDMENT NO. 10

2 On page 2, delete line 9 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

3 "D. An owner or operator:"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 11

5 On page 2, line 13, after "any" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof  
6 "civil liability as a result of posting the form, except as provided in Subsection F of this  
7 Section."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 12

9 On page 2, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

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"E. During a public health emergency, an owner or operator shall have the authority to choose which recommended mitigation measures will be implemented inside of his establishment. Notwithstanding any emergency order to the contrary, an owner or operator is only required to implement the mitigation measures he has chosen, from the recommended options, and has indicated on the posted form."

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AMENDMENT NO. 13

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On page 2, line 14, change "D." to "F."

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AMENDMENT NO. 14

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On page 2, after line 15, add the following:

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Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
