Provides relative to emergency service plans of certain providers. (gov sig) (2/3-CA7s2.1(A)) (Items #2 and #38)

Proposed legislation requires cable service providers and video service providers to annually prepare and submit an emergency service plan as to each type of service it offers to the public, including but not limited to cable, video, telephone, and internet service. Providers must submit a copy of the plan to the Governor's Office of Homeland Security (GOHSEP), the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs, and the House Committee of Commerce. The Public Service Commission (PSC) shall also be required to adopt rules and regulations to provide for the content of the emergency service plans.

Effective upon Governor's signature.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There may be an increase in revenues to the PSC to the extent that any cable service and/or video service provider is found to be in violation of the proposed legislation and is assessed a fine. The fine for a first violation is not to exceed \$1,000 and any fines subsequent violations may not exceed \$5,000.
